External Funding: Tips from the Pros:

- Apply for every fellowship for which you are eligible.
- Citizenship requirements aside, most fellowships have the same requirements, so take advantage of this and maximize your chances at winning funding.
- The key to winning fellowships is a winning proposal: hone in on your research question and leave plenty of time to polish your writing. The GSAS Fellowships Office offers workshops – see their website for details on upcoming events.
- Meet with Director of Fellowships Cynthia Verba and take advantage of GSAS resources. The Fellowships Office has a robust website with listings of internal and external pre- and postdoctoral fellowships and plenty of proposal-writing advice.
